Removing and installing the back cover







Inserting and removing the SIM card



Place the SIM card with the chip facing downwards and slide it into its housing. Make sure that it is correctly inserted. To remove the card, press it and slide it out. one touch 506D, two SIM cards can be inserted.

Charging the battery



Connect the battery charger to your phone and mains socket respectively

- The charging may take about 20 minutes to start if the hattery is flat
- Be careful not to force the plug into the socket.
- Make sure the battery is correctly inserted before connecting the charger.
- The mains socket must be near to the phone and easily accessible (avoid electric extension cables).
- When using your telephone for the first time, charge the battery fully (approximately 3 hours). You are advised to fully charge the battery (().
- To reduce power consumption and energy waste, when battery is fully charged, disconnect your charger from the plug; switch off Bluetooth when not in use; reduce the backlight time, etc.
